

**AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING ANY PERSON FROM
CONSTRUCTING, ERECTING OR MAINTAINING A
BASKETBALL STAND, BACKBOARD OR OTHER
APPARATUS IN OR NEAR A TOWNSHIP ROAD OR
RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOGAN,
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

ORDINANCE NO.: #13-2007

WHEREAS, the Township of Logan deems it in the best interest of the Municipality to restrict any person from constructing, erecting or maintaining a basketball stand backboard in or near a Township road or right-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Logan, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, with the Mayor concurring as follows:

I. Restrictions as to Basketball Standards and Other Equipment or Apparatus. No person or persons shall place in any public street, right-of-way or on the sidewalk of any public street any fixed or portable basketball net, or backboard or other equipment or apparatus for the playing of basketball or any other sport for which such an apparatus can be used nor shall such equipment or apparatus be placed on private property or in the vicinity of any public right of way such that the use of the equipment or apparatus will tend to require any user to be in and about the public right of way.

II. Attachments to Utility Poles. No person shall place, deposit, fix or allow to remain on any utility pole located on any sidewalk, adjacent lands or street any article, including but not limited to basketball hoops or other recreational equipment, in such a manner that the intended use of the article so attached to the utility pole would wholly or partially obstruct and encumber the sidewalk, street, or public right-of-way.

III. Violations and Penalties.

A. Any person violating the above provision shall be subject to a warning for the first violation, a fine of \$100.00 for the second violation and a fine not to exceed \$250 for each subsequent violation.

B. There shall be a presumption that the person or persons who have violated this provision are those who control the private property on which the equipment or apparatus is situated, or if the equipment or apparatus is in a public right-of-way, those who control the private property closest to the equipment or apparatus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Logan that this Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
