Official Code of Conduct

For Parents, Head Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Players, and Spectators

All parents, head coaches, assistant coaches, players, spectators and others will conduct themselves in an orderly, sportsmanlike and professional manner when attending a Logan Township Youth Basketball Association event (game, practice, etc.). Any report of disorderly conduct including, BUT NOT LIMITED to the following will not be tolerated:

- The initiation of a fight, scuffle, or any type of physical abuse or threats of abuse towards a player, coach, official, parent, or spectator inside and outside the gym.
- The entering of the field of play or court during a basketball event (practice, game, etc.) for the purpose of physically or verbally abusing or confronting coaches, players, or officials.
- The verbal abuse of officials, players, or spectators including the use of obscene or profane language or gestures, racial, ethnic or sexual slurs.
- Throwing or causes to be deposited any object on the field of play or court during any event (practice, game, etc.).
- Any issues that are not covered above that result in the loss of control by any parent, head coach, assistant coach, player, spectator, other, etc.
- All proscribed activity engaged in on the public property of the Township of Logan as defined in the Logan Township Code is prohibited.
- Persons engaging in proscribed activities shall be deemed in violation of the Logan Township Code and shall be subject to an action brought in the Logan Township Municipal Court.

The Logan Township Municipal Court shall have the authority to sentence persons convicted of violating the youth sports code of conduct. This can include fines, community service, banning from all youth sports events in Logan Township for up to a year or permanently, and anger management programs or equivalent counseling programs. The Logan Township Youth Basketball Association shall abide by all Logan Township Municipal Court judgements.
