

WHERE - Apply with the registrar of the town where either party resides currently.

WHEN - Apply for the license at **LEAST 72 HOURS** before the ceremony. The license is held for 72 hours after application and is valid 30 days from the time it is picked up.

Please apply during the hours of 10: 00am to 3: 30pm any weekday (except holidays.)

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Current identification with proof of residency

Social Security Numbers of both parties

Know the city of birth of both parties and their respective parents.

Know the maiden names of the mothers.

If either party has been married or in a civil union before, a copy of divorce decree, death certificate or annulment of the most recent marriage or union must be presented.

Name and address of person performing ceremony.

Name of municipality where ceremony will take place and date of ceremony.

Address where party can be reached after ceremony.

WHO MUST APPEAR

The Bride and Groom

One witness over 18 years of age that knows the bride and groom

COST

\$28.00 payable by check to Logan Township or in cash

\$2.00 to receive a certified copy, payable by cash or check at the time of application

AFTER THE CEREMONY

After the Officiant has completed the certificate, you will receive a pink copy and the person performing the ceremony will retain the blue copy for his/her records.

Once again, please check it for accuracy, before it is registered with the State of New Jersey. **The pink copy is not a certified copy for your marriage, it is a keep sake.**

You must obtain the certified copy from the Registrar in the municipality where the marriage took place. Please wait at least 5 days before contacting the registrar. You will need a certified copy of your marriage license for legal documentation.
