

# Notice to Contractors and Pool Installers

\*\*\*\*\*NOTICE\*\*\*\*\*

**Dewatering into inlets (VIA THE STREET) is illegal under the NJDEP Regulations without authorization.**

Submission of a Request for Authorization Certification form must be submitted to NJDEP fourteen (14) days prior to the discharge activity. You may dewater into an approved tank.

*In accordance with N.J.S.A. 58:10A et seq., this general permit includes Best Management Practices (BMPs) and/or provides temporary treatment units as well as self-monitoring rather than numeric limitations. No application submittal to the division is necessary for this permit; however, qualifying dischargers must submit a Request for Authorization Certification form 14 days prior to the anticipated discharge date. **Also:**

Unless you are using a private driveway, there shall be no off loading of “track” equipment on Township roads without matting, **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

Any damage to TOWNSHIP curbs and/or sidewalks is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED!!!**

Bridging of the curbing and sidewalks is **REQUIRED**

Bridging plans **MUST** be submitted along with your construction permits. Lack of the above may result in a delay in issuing required work permits.

Prior to any off loading of equipment, digging, and/or crossing the Township Right of Way with any motorized equipment, the Logan Township Public Works Department shall be notified in advance.

This advanced notice will allow the DPW time in scheduling to meet the excavator so as not to hold up your project.
